



## **EFFSC REJECTION OF DISHONEST SPIN DOCTORING OF BASIC EDUCATION MODEL AND DHET SALE OF STUDENTS INTO DEBT.**

The EFFSC finally notes the address by both the DHET and Basic Education. They have equally attempted to register proposals that speak to investigating a possibility of salvaging the year. Though we are sympathetic to their delivery of our demands as far as adhering to our call to ensure e-learning isn't exclusive and that institutions of learning are capacitated to prioritise safety and student health. We still maintain removing restrictions before they have done their job of suppressing the spread of the virus in the name of salvaging the year is reckless and irresponsible.

The ANC must stop using pension documents for deployments into ministries that are responsible for future of the country. We need these ministries led by ministers that will live past their attempts to make idiocy fashionable. We are most disappointingly and appalled to learn that Blade Nzimande's is in cahoots with opportunistic financial institutions which seek to profit from those most marginalized by eLearning.
